#### **SYNOPSIS**

## **DESCRIPTION**

mailrm attempts to remove the locally queued mail messages named on its command line by submitting mail messages that cancel the queued messages.

The Obsoletes: message header is the mechanism used to accomplish this. The *router* turns it into a message control file directive that the *scheduler* implements. The *scheduler* will of course do its best to ensure only the owner of a message can cancel it. Therefore this program is only useful to whomever originally sent the message to be cancelled. The super user is not treated specially.

The *id* is the message file id of a to-be-cancelled message, as it is reported by *mailq*. It is not the message id, although that is the information that is actually sought for the Obsoletes: header contents. *mailrm* will rummage through message control files in *POSTOFFICE*/transport to retrieve the message id for a given message file id.
